EET is a mandate that requires airlines to provide pilots with enhanced training in aerodynamic stalls, wind gusts, bounced landings, icing, and upset prevention and recovery training (UPRT) skills beginning in early 2019.

Following the amendments, operators must add EET into their approved training programs by the timeframe mandated by their regulatory body.
